Dear Residents,

There is a proposal underway to **rezone** 26 acres at the base of North Table Mountain – located about a 1/2 mile west of The Trails – from single family residents to **multi-family**, **high-density rentals**. If approved, allowed dwellings would increase from **1 dwelling** per ¼ acre to **8 dwellings** per ¼ acre.

The rezoning proposal is not compatible with the Master Plan for North Table Mountain and undermines the unique character of our community.

## The Trails HOA Board is opposed to this proposal.

It is critical that residents are aware and informed of this proposal and the likely negative impacts to our community, including (but not limited to):

- Increased traffic on Easley Road, Highway 93, W 58<sup>th</sup> and W 60<sup>th</sup> Avenues
- Greater burden on overcrowded community schools (as an example, student-to-teacher ratio is 18% above state average at Fairmount and Mitchell) alongside certain upcoming budget reductions (potentially up to \$70M)
- Increased flooding potential, particularly for homes in close proximity or in the flood plain of Ramsletter Creek; these homes are already experiencing increased water volume due to development west of The Trails
- Increased trail traffic on North Table Mountain and surrounding trails
- Disturbance of local wildlife and habitat
- Greater burden on Law Enforcement and Fire services
- Precedent for future rezoning proposals that do not benefit the community
